Fruity, rounded, everyday red

Silva Family Wines Cabernet Sauvignon/Carmenère 2017, Colchagua Valley, Chile

A terrific intense and fresh, wine with aromas of ripe red fruits and toffee. Soft tannins and cherry notes that lead into an agreeable finish.

Good with or without food.

Berticot, Côtes de Duras, Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Garonne, France

Dry in style, this delicious white offers aromas of blackcurrant leaf and freshly cut grass, and the taste of ripe gooseberries. A fantastic all-rounder.

Classic Club Claret

Château La Tuilerie du Puy 2014, Bordeaux Supérieur, France

This is amazing Claret for the price! Enjoy the scent and taste of sweet, juicy blackcurrants and blackberries, backed by the support of firm tannins. Great with red meat dishes. £19.60

Classic Club White

Château La Tuilerie du Puy 2016, "Entre-Deux-Mers", France

This Entre-Deux-Mers has good aromas of grapefruit and exotic fruits. Soft in the mouth with pleasant freshness. On the palate has fruity aromatic persistence and notes of white flowers and citrus. £19.60

Club Champagne

Gardet Brut Champagne NV, France

Made from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier vine varieties, on the nose a mixture of flowers and fruits, the flavour is ripe with a good length on the palate. £56.00

WHITE WINES

Muscadet Sèvre et Maine, Sur Lie, 2015/16, Domaine Manoir DBH, France

Pale yellow in colour with aromatic, exotic fruits on the nose, lively rich concentrated citrus fruit on the palate. £21.00

Mâcon-Lugny Les Charmes, 2016, Albert Bichot, France

Lovely pale yellow with golden highlights. On the nose peach and apricot with a touch of lemon. Full bodied on the palate with good depth and lovely length. £29.50

Trentino DOC Pinot Grigio, 2014, Casata Monfort, Italy

This wine is pale yellow with copper highlights. Delicate and fruity aromas on the nose, dry and agreeable on the palate. Well balanced and elegant wine. £26.00

Viña Casa Silva Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2014, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Chilean SB is generally less pungent than its New Zealand or French cousins, so choose this if you want a light white that still bounces with green, herbaceous flavours. £24.60

Delheim Chenin Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch, South Africa

An incredibly zesty wine packed with lively lemon and peachy fruit. A great stylistic wine with a creaminess and touch of honey that marks it out a Chenin. £24.25

Saint-Veran, Cuvée Clos du Château, 2015, France

A very expressive wine with aromas of peach, apricot, and vanilla notes. Ripe fruit with toasty notes, balanced with good minerality. £42.00

Cirro Sauvignon Blanc, 2015, Marlborough, New Zealand

Cirro is full of classic, mouth watering Marlborough flavours. Intense passionfruit, papaya and guava aromas fill the glass, the palate shows juicy flavours and the finish is long and refreshing. £27.90

RED WINES

Côtes du Rhône, Prestige du Colombier, 2016, France

Intense ruby colour with purple hints. Well balanced earthy aromas of red fruits and spices with a touch of vanilla. Long fruity finish with mild tannins. £23.50

Brouilly Henry Fessy, 2015, Crus de Beaujolais, France

Good colour, full-bodied revealing aromas of plum and peaches. A marvellous accompaniment with steak and cheese. £32.00

Château Haut Piquat 2010 Lussac St Emilion, France

Situated at the edge of Lussac, this is a fine wine with a deep purple colour and complex nose of red fruits and vanilla. Goes very well with meat, game and cheese. £32.25

Casa Silva Pinot Noir 2015 Reserva, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Red with violet hues, on the nose, fruity with notes of strawberries, on the plate, fresh, with good acidity, very agreeable tannins and note of ripe red fruit. £23.80

Château de Paraza Cuvée Spéciale 2015 AOC Minervois, Languedoc, France

A rich full bodied intense wine with ripe fruit and elegant length. £24.00

Château Batailley 2009, Grand Cru Classé Pauillac CB, France

Blackcurrant and berries on the nose with an earthy charm, good levels of attractive fruit with ultra-fine tannins. £68.00

ROSÉ WINES

Casa Silva, Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé, 2107, Chile

Attractive pale pink, hints of raspberries on the nose, on the palate, round, fresh with very good acidity and notes of ripe cherries. Excellent finish. £21.00

DESSERT WINE

Delheim Edelspatz 2014, Stellenbosch, South Africa (37.5cl bottle)

Single Vineyard Noble Late Harvest Rhine Riesling. Aromas of dried apricot, quince and kumquat. Elegant and intense with ripe fruit and well balanced acidity. £24.50

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINES

Moët et Chandon Brut Imperial Champagne NV, France

One of the timeless classics. The tongue-tingling prick of each bursting bubble releases a sea of rich flavours, liquid brioche, hazelnuts and all-butter biscuits.

Anna de Codorníu Reserva Cava Brut NV, Spain (20cl bottle)

A lively, dry sparkling wine, produced by the traditional method, that is often described as “feminine” owing to the high proportion of Chardonnay grapes used in the blend. £8.70

Vino dei Poeti Prosecco NV, Veneto, Italy

Delightfully light and refreshing, this fizz delivers an alluring bouquet of wild flowers and the appetizing taste of orchard fruits. £29.15
